	Drop-In Day Shelter: The Day Shelter provides a safe, restful place for homeless youth and helps them begin moving out of homelessness. Services include access to a hot meal, clothing, personal care items, shower and laundry facilities, and a place to rest. There is also a Social Worker to assist youth in developing a plan for their future.
